If she wasn't she didn't know when she would come back. Pa started for Nebraska July 14th and came back a weak from last Friday he likes it awful well out there he bought 160 acres of land. Did Eva McXxx tell you we had an organ the name of it is the Chicago Cottage. Nora is taking lessons and I am a going to when school is out. The music teacher name is Mrs Davenport. I will have to close for this time so good by Write Soon **From Mary**
