I received your letter and was pleased to hear from you and home as I did not hear from **Mary** yet.

Well we planted James Monahan today. I was pall Bearer. **Aunt Kate Malone** and Patsy was down. I went to the wake the first night. I heard they had a little excitement in the town of Coopersville one Sunday night not long since and **Katie** was in it. That is virtually. I do believe it not because I call the parties from which I heard it good authority, but because it seems natural.

I got a valentine and I think it was from Lizzie Golden,

"Mary": Mary was Elizabeth and Martin's sister.

"Aunt Kate Malone": Elizabeth and Martin's dad was Patrick Golden. Patrick Golden's Sister was Kate Golden. Kate Golden married Patrick Malone.

"Katie": Katie was Elizabeth and Martin's sister
