The envelope contained 2 cents postage
The address was Miss Lizzie Golden, Dennison, Michigan
Hand written on the front was the following words
10 front, 6 1/2 of Baelr (Boelk, Boelr, Back)

Extend invitation to your brothers and sisters and their friends whom you may meet.
